

No First Use, Never Any Use of Nuclear Weapons

Appeal: no first – never use of nuclear weapons

We demand from all politicians and political leaders:

- Stop the verbal escalation, stop making any statements and decisions that could destroy everyone's future;
- Take scientific advice as a guideline for your decisions, and make decisions that allow a future for all of us;
- Remember the inferno of Hiroshima and Nagasaki, listen to the Hibakusha survivors, and take history and their personal testimony into account.

We demand from all governments, especially those with nuclear weapons and those in military alliances with them:

- Urgently declare publicly that you subscribe to the no-first-use policy for nuclear weapons or other weapons of mass destruction, and refrain from any use of these weapons;
- Join the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons launched by the United Nations.

Appeal: no first – never use of nuclear weapons

- **Press release:**

Nobel laureates and well-known scientists urgently warn with the appeal "No First Use, Never Any Use of Nuclear Weapons" about the dangers of a deliberate or unwanted use of nuclear weapons. The war in Ukraine, which is strongly condemned, has brought Europe very close to a nuclear war. In view of the unimaginable dangers and consequences, the scientists can no longer remain silent: An attack with even a smaller tactical nuclear weapon could lead to a nuclear war that would mean millions of deaths in a very short time, and would destroy and contaminate very large areas.

The scientists emphasize that everyone must work together to solve the world's major problems, the climate crisis, food crisis, social and energy crisis.

A central demand is the explicit commitment not to be the first party and never to use nuclear weapons and to accede to the UN Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons.

The call was supported by 14 Nobel Prize winners and more than 50 international scientists as first signatories. The appeal was published today on change.org and on Science4Peace webpage

Publication Strategy of CERN experiments

- Publication strategy in HEP experiments (CERN etc) not yet settled, further discussions ongoing. New proposals:

Proposal C:

Authors affiliated with Russian or Belarussian institutes, or with JINR, sign the Collaboration's scientific publications with their names and ORCID identifiers¹ (where available), and the institute affiliation is replaced, respectively, by the reference:

"Affiliated with an institute [or an international laboratory] covered by a cooperation agreement with CERN."

The complete author list including all institute affiliations is made available to the journal in a non-public form for the purpose of machine-readable analysis or as historical data.²

No acknowledgement to the Russian and Belarussian funding agencies and JINR is made. On request, the experiment management will release a certificate attesting the contribution of the aforementioned institutes and funding agencies, or of JINR, to the work presented in the publication.

Publication Strategy of CERN experiments

Proposal D:

All authors and their ORCID identifiers (where available) are listed on the publication. No institute affiliation is listed.

The complete author list including all institute affiliations is made available to the journal in a non-public form for the purpose of machine-readable analysis or as historical data.

On request, the experiment management will release a certificate attesting the contribution of the institutes and funding agencies to the work presented in the publication.

Acknowledgments of funding agencies are included in the papers, except those referring to the Russian Federation, Belarus, or JINR.

The paper further contains the following statements in the acknowledgements:

“The CERN Council has taken measures against institutes and funding agencies of the Russian Federation, the Republic of Belarus, and JINR (CERN/3626, CERN/3637, CERN/3638).”

“In line with the principles that apply to scientific publishing and the CERN policy in matters of scientific publications, the XYZ Collaboration recognises the work of all those who have contributed to the experiment used to obtain the results described in this paper.”
